The Scholarship: The Lakeshore Education Association invites applications for its \$1000 scholarship to be awarded this spring. The scholarship is paid in two installments of \$500, the first at the awards presentation and the second upon notification of the successful completion of the first semester of the recipient's freshman year. Eligible applicants are Lakeshore high school seniors. No scholarships will be awarded to applicants who accept appointment to a U.S. service academy.

The five selection criteria are listed below. After each, in parenthesis, is a figure that indicates the relative importance of the criteria.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- ✓ ***High School Grades***-(40%): Attach a copy of your high school transcript which includes your GPA, class rank and size, and ACT and/or SAT scores.
- ✓ ***Essay***-(40%): Attach a 100-200 word essay describing your college plans, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship.
- ✓ ***School and Community Service/Activities***-(20%): On a separate sheet of paper, describe in 100-200 words your participation in high school activities such as sports, drama, music, clubs, and community/church service.
- ✓ Eligible applicants ***must attend Lakeshore Public Schools.***

\$1000 scholarship to one recipient; paid in 2-\$500 installments

SELECTION CRITERIA

- ✓ **High School Grades-** (40%): Attach a copy of your high school transcript which includes your GPA, class rank and size, and ACT and/or SAT scores.
- ✓ **Essay-** (40%): Attach a 100-200-word essay describing your college plans, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship.
- ✓ **School and Community Service/Activities-** (20%): On a separate sheet of paper, describe in 100-200 words your participation in high school activities such as sports, drama, music, clubs, and community/church service.
- ✓ **Teacher or Counselor input**

PROCESS

- ❖ Selection committee made up of 3-5 LEA members and HS teachers, as determined by LEA President.
- ❖ Selection will be determined by the first week of May.
- ❖ LEA President or representative will award scholarship at awards presentation.
- ❖ To receive second installment, recipient should bring Mr. Milletics a college transcript showing GPA of 2.75 or above following their first complete semester.
